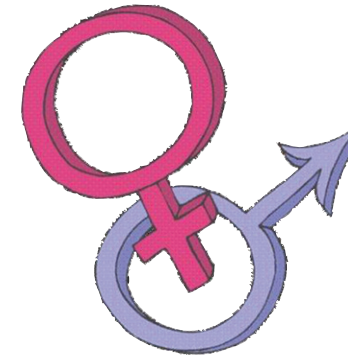

The Sankey Clinic



What is the Sankey Clinic?

The Sankey Clinic is a specialist clinic where advice and support is given to women who may not want to carry on with their pregnancy.

The aim of the clinic is to provide free confidential counselling and assessment to women that live or have a GP in the Warrington area, who are considering an abortion.

Please note: Abortions are not carried out at the Sankey Clinic

What happens at the Clinic?

Your appointment will take approximately one hour.

On arrival you will be seen by a member of staff who will complete the necessary paperwork.

You will then see another member of staff for counselling.

Following your counselling, you will see a doctor who will carry out an assessment, this may include; a vaginal examination, blood test and a urine test. Furthermore, the doctor will provide you with information on the suitable method available to you, dependant on the stage of your pregnancy and ask you to sign (give consent) the completed paperwork.

Finally, you will be given the date and time of your appointment and details of the clinic in Liverpool where you will have your abortion.

Please make sure you have had a positive pregnancy test before making an appointment

To book an appointment telephone the central booking line on **01925 644202** stating that you require an appointment at the 'Sankey Clinic'.

When making an appointment by telephone please make sure that you have the following information to hand...

- Your name
- Your address
- Date of birth
- Your GP Surgery
- Date of your last period

Contact telephone during office hours (Mon-Fri) from:
9am – 12.30pm & 2pm – 4pm

Alternatively, you can be referred to the clinic via your own GP, Sexual & Reproductive Health Clinic, or Youth Advice Shop.
